# Member of the Month

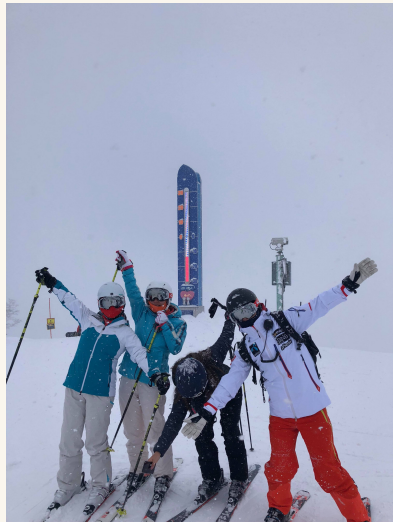

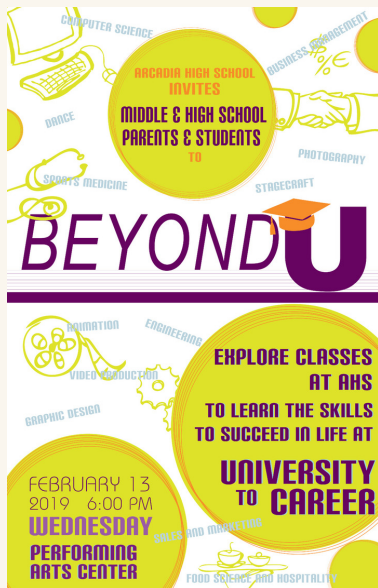
